- A bag of a grain costs \$23 for 50 pounds, which lasts two days.
- A bale of hay costs \$10; we use four bales a day.
- Supplements cost from \$15 to \$60 per month for the eight horses who need them.
- Horseshoes cost up to \$165 for a full set or \$50 for a trim every six weeks.
- Shavings cost \$5 per bag at one bag per stall every two to three days.
